3. City of Richmond

Overview

Richmond is a culturally diverse and geographically unique community located within Metropolitan Vancouver. Downtown Vancouver is 20-25 minutes north of Richmond. Incorporated in 1879, it is a unique island city within the Fraser river delta. The population is

223,000.

Richmond has been experiencing growth and change with remarkable speed, transforming from rural, community to an international city with a balance of urban, suburban family and rural areas. Recently, there has been rapid growth in the city's downtown.

The "Canada Line", a rapid transit system, connects Richmond with downtown Vancouver in 25 minutes. During the peak day and early evening, it operates every 8 minutes. Clearly this is the easiest and most hassle-free way to go downtown.





The Vancouver International Airport is located within Richmond and is 13 km or 15 minutes from the Richmond Ice Centre. Getting around Richmond - dating back to its farming heritage the city's road network is oriented "North-South" and "East-West", with the major North-South roads being named No. 1 Road (furthest to the west) to No.6 Road adjacent to the Richmond Ice Centre. A major freeway (Highway 99) bisects Richmond connecting the U.S. Border and Delta with Vancouver. Steveston Highway, a major east-west road connects the arena with Hwy 99 and the historic village of Steveston to the west.

The village of Steveston dates back to the 1880s as a fishing port and a major salmon canning centre at the mouth of the Fraser River. Japanese Canadians formed a large part of Steveston's original population. Steveston maintains the character of a quaint, historic fishing village, with over 600 fishing boats—Canada's largest fleet. Located 8 km to the west of the rink, Steveston, offers a broad choice of $_{\mbox{4}\,\mbox{\,|\,}\mbox{\,|\,}\mbox{\,|\,}\mbox{\,|\,}}$ restaurants, and its historic sites are well work the visit.



The Richmond Ice Centre has six regulation size rinks and offers year-round ice. The arena complex has a pro shop operated by Cyclone Taylor Sports and Stanley's Bar and Grill.

The Richmond Ice Centre is home to the Richmond Ravens Female Hockey Association, Richmond Minor Hockey Association, Richmond Devils Hockey Club (Senior), Richmond Ringette, Connaught Figure Skating Club, Richmond Youth Roller Hockey League and Coast Hockey League.


