






Tier 4 U18 Championships

where is Prince Rupert?

Prince Rupert is a vibrant coastal city located on the northern edge of British Columbia, surrounded by stunning natural beauty. Here's how you can reach us:



Driving

From Vancouver: Take the Cariboo Hwy/BC-97 N1, then take the Yellowhead Hwy W/BC-16 all the way to Prince Rupert. This scenic route takes about 18-20 hours, so plan for an overnight stop (Prince George is about half-way). Make sure to check the road report www.drivebc.ca

Flying

Air Canada offers daily flights from Vancouver to the Prince Rupert Airport (YPR) on Digby Island. Upon arrival, a short ferry ride included in the price of your plane ticket will take you to the city.

You may also to choose to fly to Terrace where there are other flight options, and then drive to Prince Rupert (143km).

BC Ferries

Prince Rupert is a key terminal for BC Ferries, with routes connecting from Vancouver Island and other coastal communities. Hop aboard in Port Hardy and enjoy a scenic 16-hour sailing along the Inside Passage to Prince Rupert.

Shopping

Cow Bay

Cow Bay is a quirky, colourful district where restored historic buildings house artist collectives, shops, and offices. Walk on boardwalks built over the water on pilings and smell the salty air from the harbour. Wander through the wide array of shops and galleries, browsing everything from local art and pottery to modern clothing boutiques and artisan food markets.

Rupert Square Mall

The Rupert Square Shopping Centre is located on 2nd Avenue in the heart of downtown Prince Rupert. It has been open to the public since 1974. The 20 businesses located in the mall offer a wide range of services and products.

Historic Downtown

Little restaurants half-hide themselves among the shops, banks, gift shops, and galleries. Like in Cow Bay, there's a lot to see here. The odd historic building peeks out from between its more modern neighbours; beautiful old houses gaze down from the top of the hill; a small gallery sits next to a salon, next to a clothing shop, across from City Hall. There's jewellery, paintings, clothing, gifts, and souvenirs, books, and lots more.



what to do in Prince Rupert

Prince Rupert is compact and highly walkable, with most amenities, restaurants, and attractions located within a short distance from local hotels.

Other Ideas

- Museum of Northern British Columbia: Dive into the region's rich Indigenous and maritime history.
- North Pacific Cannery: A National Historic Site that offers a glimpse into the fishing and canning industries that shaped our community.
- Butze Rapids Trail: A well-maintained 5km loop that will take you down to the water's edge, including a viewpoint of the spectacular reversing tidal flow.
- Rushbrook Trail: For an easy loop in town, take a stroll down Rushbrook Trail. You'll find the
 trailhead just behind the Bob's on the Rocks building. Newly renovated in 2018, it features three
 impressive suspension bridges and stunning views up the harbour as far as Tuck Inlet.
- Prince Rupert Wildlife Tours: Go on a whale-watching tour to witness the incredible marine life of our coastal waters.
- Pop into the Visitor Information Centre located and ask the folks there for a list of current events.
- Stop by the Port Interpretive Centre and check out the interactive exhibits; the newly redesigned space offers a glimpse into current operations and future growth at the Port.
- Catch a show at Famous Players Theatre.
- Get your workout on at Anytime Fitness, The Gym, or at the Pool Gym.
- Have a great time at Hot Shots Family Entertainment (arcade, pool tables etc.).
- Swimming: Dive into fun at the Earl Mah Aquatic Centre, featuring a pool, waterslide, and hot tub.
- SwingSmith Batting Cage: Practice your swing or try out baseball in this indoor batting facility.
- Swing Shack Golf Simulator: Challenge yourself with virtual golf on world-class courses.
