Responsibilities:

- Serve as the official spokesperson of the team
- Be a positive role model that consistently demonstrates, promotes and encourages the highest standard of behavior
- Make the rink and team events a positive and fun experience for all athletes
- Plan on and off-ice activities in consultation with the assistant coaches
- Create and implement a team building plan
- Create a team culture that promotes the concepts of transformational coaching by putting as much emphasis on relationships as the technical and tactical side of the game
- Establish rules/expectations for the team and oversee the supervision of play
- Ensure a safe and positive environment is created on and off the ice for the team
- Coordinate the delegation of responsibilities to the assistant coaches and manager
- Clearly establish your expectations and process for parent communication
- Coach the team in all games and practices
- Design practice plans in consultation with the assistant coaches
- Introduce the full-ice game to players who are experiencing the larger surface for the first time by educating them on the playing rules and differences from U9 hockey
- Create/provide a goalie development plan, designate a coach to be the direct link to goalies
- Coordinate player evaluation and selection in conjunction with the Association
- Plan, implement and oversee pre-game preparation and communication with the team
- Submit a year-end report which contains the following information:
 - o player performance evaluations, evaluation of team's performance, outline of practice plans & game strategy, recommendations on how to improve the program
