



PLACEMENT REQUIREMENTS

- Experience with coaching female hockey players
- Coach Certification – Minimum Development 1, preferred High Performance 1
- Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Person's Check
- Respect in Sport – Activity Leader Certification
- Must have good administrative, organizational and communication skills.
- Ability to build relationships with Minor Hockey Associations, District Hockey Associations, Hockey Canada Accredited Schools and BC Hockey Programming.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide guidance and support for Female Coaches across BC
- Set up mentors with new female coaches
- Provide support and learning opportunities for coach mentors
- Weekly or Monthly reporting to Female Hockey Coordinator

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES

- Assist in hosting and setting up professional development / education sessions for new and experienced coaches
- Build an inventory of experienced female leaders, players, coaches and officials from associations across the province
- Assist in administering the Minor Hockey Association Buddy Up Program.
- Assist in setting up Female AAA and CSSHL teams to work with female Minor Hockey Associations to help facilitate skill sessions
- Set up coaching workshops for female AAA and CSSHL teams
- Support U18A teams to volunteer with lower divisions, speak to younger female players and to volunteer with female recruitment initiatives.
- Encourage MHAs to utilize older female players as on ice helpers for female recruitment initiatives
