Arenas

The Alberni Valley Multiplex is located at 3737 Roger Street in Port Alberni, BC. A multi-use facility, the Multiplex has two separate ice sheets with a total of ten changerooms, a lobby on the main floor, and a large lounge upstairs equipped with a full-service concession and bar.

Weyerhaeuser Arena - Upon entering the main front entrance, participants that continue through the right-hand set of doors will find themselves in Weyerhaeuser Arena, home to the Alberni Valley Bulldogs of the BCHL. An Olympic sized ice surface, Weyerhaeuser Arena features a capacity of 1500 patrons, four fully equipped changerooms, a broadcast booth, as well as a video streaming booth to control the brand-new LED entertainment screen.

Coulson Arena - Located next to Weyerhaeuser Arena, players and spectators will stay left upon entering the main foyer. The lobby offers a warm area for spectators to view games through the large windows looking onto Coulson Rink. Like Weyerhaeuser, Coulson Rink has four fully equipped change-rooms plus an additional female change room equipped with showers and washroom. Both Weyerhaeuser Arena and Coulson Rink provide access to the Upper Lounge; a great viewing area for spectators to relax and watch either ice surface while staying warm.
