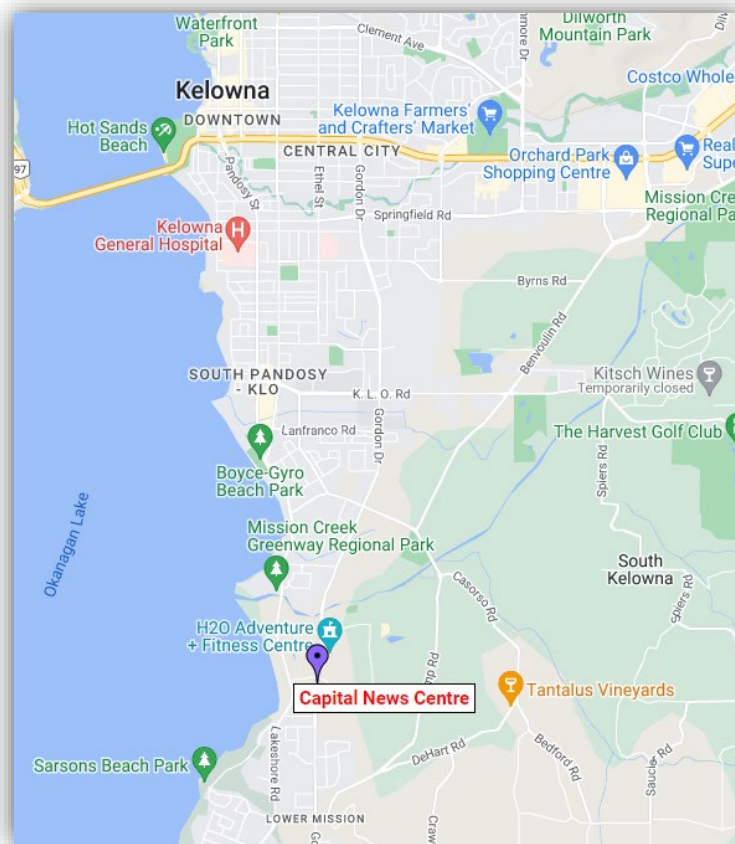

Kelowna is located on the traditional, ancestral, unceded territory of the Syilx/Okanagan people.

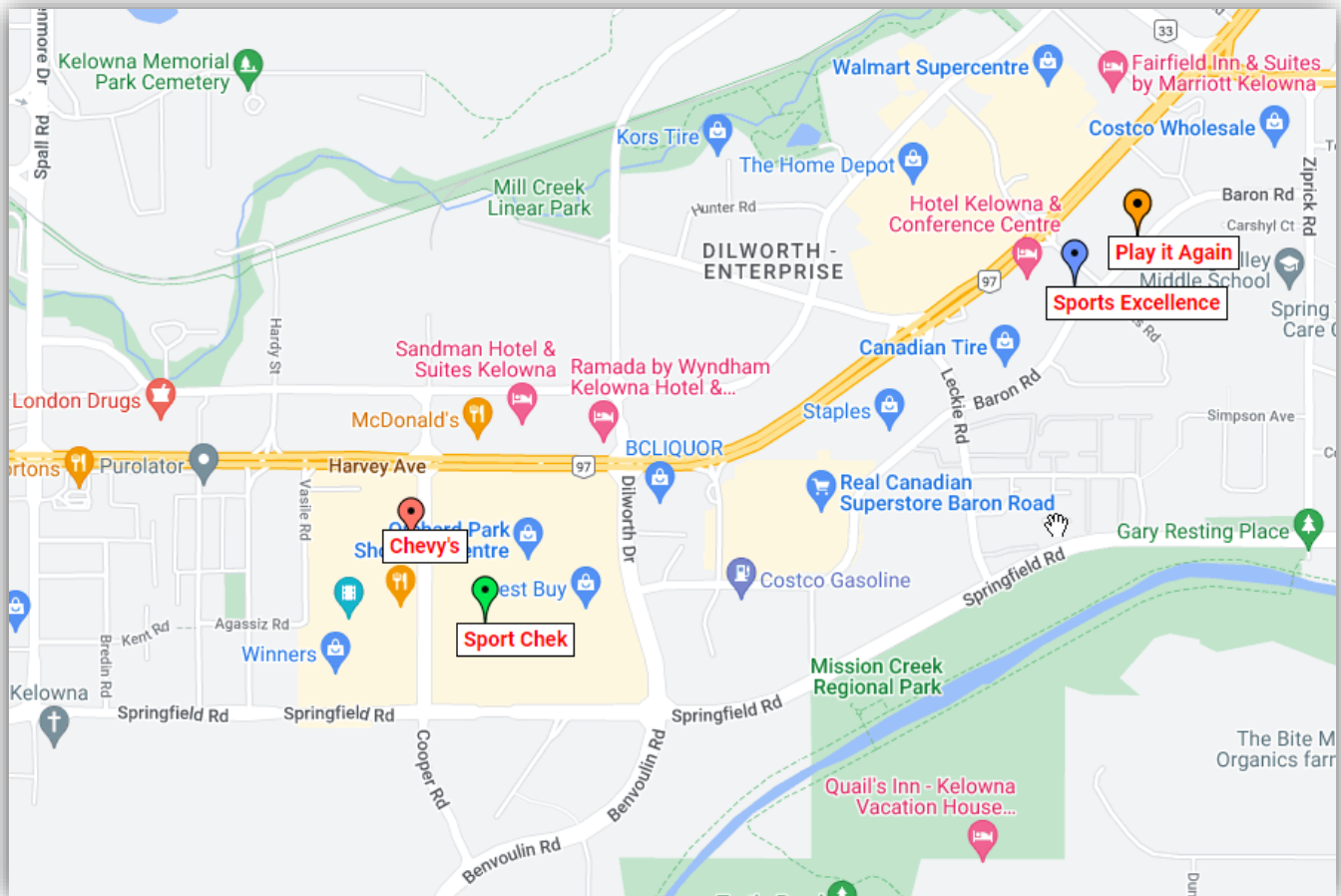

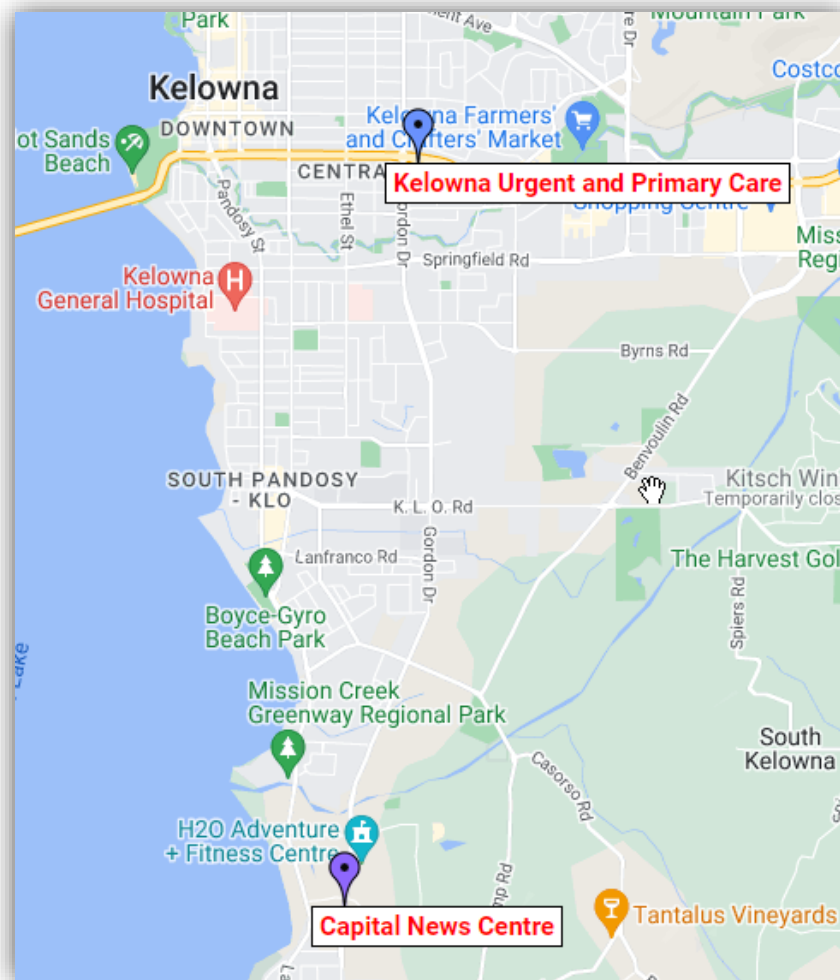

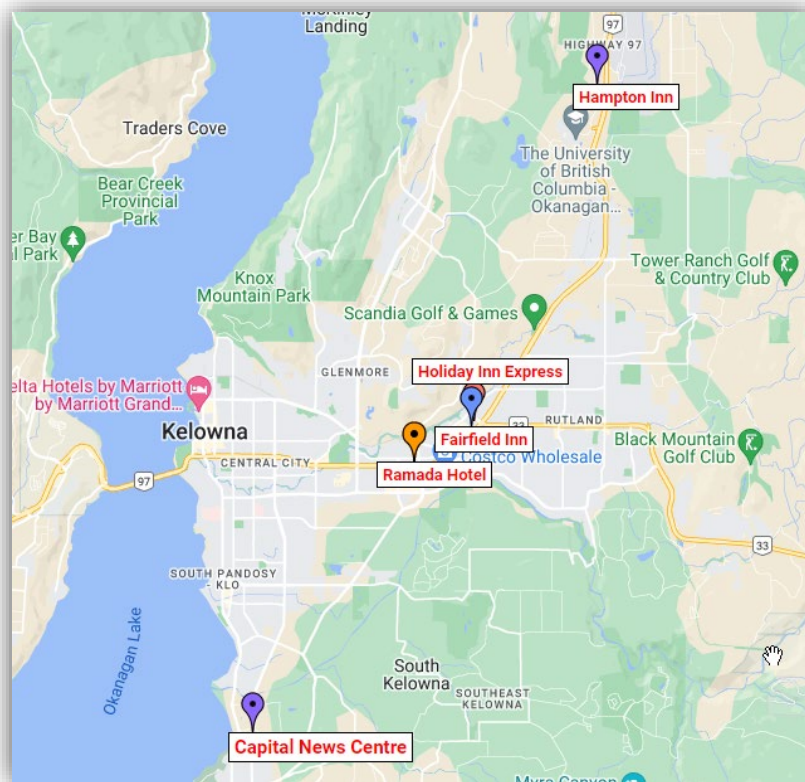
