WELCOME VISITORS

Arriving at Hollyburn

All players and team officials may arrive one hour before games and practices. Teams arriving by bus should drop off and pick up in the lower-level visitors' parking lot. Please ensure buses are not left idling and do not block other vehicles. A map of the facility is on the next page.

Parking

Visitor parking is available in the lower parking lot, with stairs leading up to the Sports Entrance. Buses should park in the lower lot and be turned off while parked. Please avoid parking in the Member Parking areas.

Athletics Entrance - Hockey Guest Entrance

All members and guests carrying sporting equipment (hockey bags, pucks, wheeled bags) must use the Athletics Entrance. Signage inside will direct you to the ice rink and change rooms. After the game, please exit through the Athletics Entrance.

Dressing Rooms

A dressing room schedule is posted on the doors to the ice rink. Visiting teams using the large ice for minor hockey games are typically assigned dressing rooms 3 or 4.

As per BC Hockey rules, cameras, cell phones, and vapor/e-cigarettes are not allowed in the dressing rooms. Coaches and managers are responsible for leaving the dressing room in the same condition it was before use. Any damages will be the responsibility of the visiting team's officials.

Warm Ups

Visiting teams may use one of two pre-game warm-up areas:

1. Paved parking area on the west side of the building, accessed via doors under the score clock
2. Indoor gym, if it is empty and unused

If these areas are unavailable or if ice rink access is needed through the west side doors, contact Member Services at 604-922-0161. Teams are not permitted to warm up in hallways or other indoor spaces.



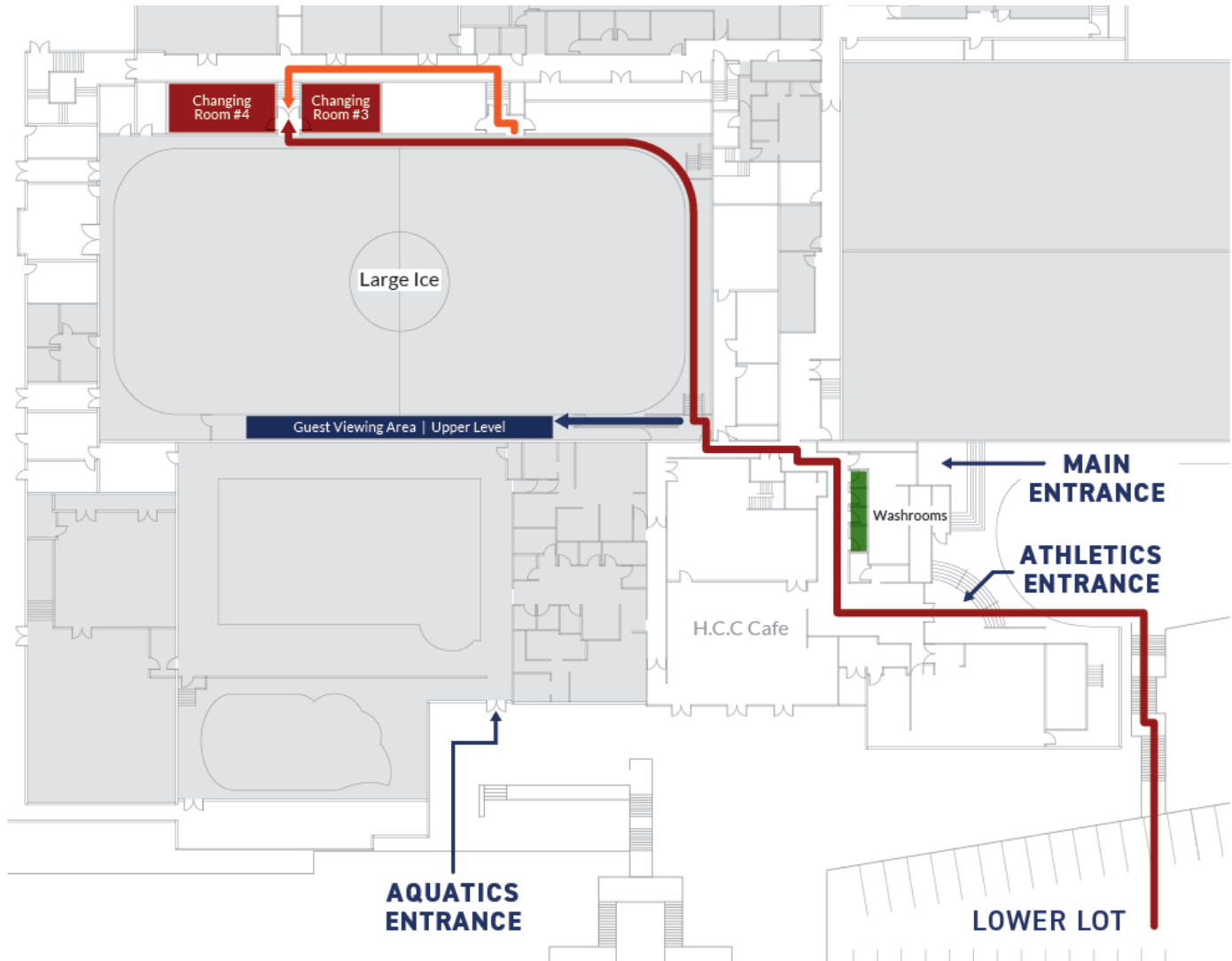
HOCKEY GUEST ENTRANCE

Directions:

1. Park in the **lower parking lot**, in one of the guest spaces.
2. Walk up the stairs.
3. Turn left and go through the **Athletics Entrance**.
4. Before entering the **Cafe** turn right, and go down the hallway.
5. At the junction, turn left and go down the hallway until you see the **Large Ice** door, proceed through and head up to the rink.
6. Walk around to the far side of the rink to find the changing rooms.
 - **DETOUR:** If the benches are full, exit through the doors and go left to the second set of doors to reach the changing rooms.

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

EQUIPMENT	INSPECT	BASIC THINGS TO LOOK FOR
PANTS	Condition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No tears, loose threads &/or dangling belts/straps. - Inside zippers done up and working.
STICK		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Plug is in butt end of the stick (top). - Blade has no sharp edges, breakages
HELMET	Condition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Must have visible CSA label, snug chin strap, ear guards, be tape free & not painted. - Numbers, team decals and decals supporting a cause (ie. Humbolt, Cancer etc.) are permitted - No cracks in shell or padding.
FACEMASK	Condition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No metal bars broken on cages - Tight screws and if replacements, NOT too long. - Straps snug with stretch in elastic - Clips in place. - NO cracks in plastic - watch for rust at wire seams
GLOVES	Condition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - High enough so covers wrist. Firm fingers, thumb and back padding - Palms soft and pliable. NO holes near fingers or in palm larger than a quarter) - No loose threads
NECKGUARD	Condition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fits snug enough around neck - MUST have BNQ certification, be free of fabric cuts - Velcro strap NOT worn and in good working order - Must not be altered in any way - Rips or tears should be sewn. - No tape wrapped around neckguard

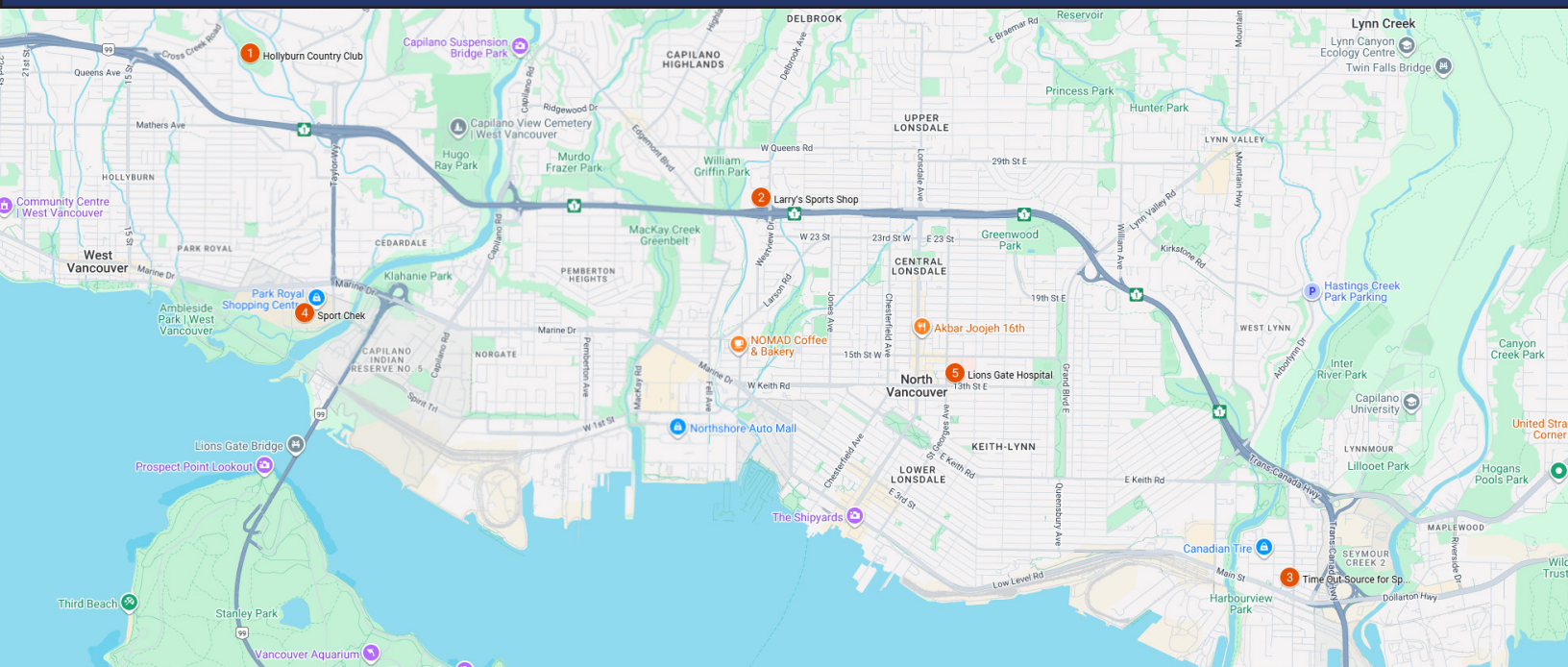
