Required Information:

Once your team has earned their spot in the Championships, we will require the following information:

1. Official Team Picture: Highest resolution jpeg will be required for use in the program and the other print material. Please include names of everyone in order as they appear in the team photo.

2. Association Logo: Please send an EPS or illustrator image of your association logo and your home jersey colours.

3. Contact information: Please provide Head Coach and Managers names, contact numbers and their address.

4. Sponsor Acknowledgements: All teams will be given the opportunity to acknowledge their team logo on their team page in the Championship program.

Mandatory Equipment Checks:

Coaches will be responsible for mandatory equipment checks prior to the championship event. Teams will be forwarded criteria from the hosting team regarding equipment to prior to the event. Coaches are responsible for checking and ensuring equipment meets standards. After the check, coaches will submit a completed form (with signature) to the hosting team or return the signed form at the coaches' meeting.

A Fair Play Award will be awarded at the close of the tournament. The Fair Play Award encompasses many aspects of hockey and manifests in a variety of ways on and off the ice. A bit about The Columbia Valley and Invermere

This area has been home to Ktunaxa and Secwepemc Peoples since time immemorial.

Explorer David Thompson set up a trading post between Invermere and Wilmer in 1810. Later in 1890, Edmund Johnston formed a settlement and named it Copper City. In 1900, Lewis Garnett purchased the settlement and renamed it Canterbury. In 1909 a large portion of the townsite was acquired by The Columbia Valley Fruit Land Ltd. and was then renamed to what we now know as our beautiful town of Invermere.

Invermere is nestled in the Columbia Valley, with the Rocky Mountains



to the East and the Purcell Mountains to the West. It boasts its beauty anytime of year and has endless trails to hike, bike and explore.

In the summer, spend the day at the beach, on the water and in the winter enjoy Lake Windermere as it transforms into the world's longest skating trail called The Whiteway. The Whiteway at over 30 km, is a multi-use winter recreation area offering opportunities to ice skate, cross-country ski or walk on a thoughtfully groomed trail connecting the communities of Invermere and Windermere.





Radium Hot springs is located approximately 17km North of Invermere where you can find the famous hot pools to relax and rejuvenate. <u>This is also where you will find the community hall that the</u> <u>banquet will be hosted.</u>

As you drive or walk around the town and explore the quaint shops and galleries, keep an eye open for some big horned sheep that graze along the hillside and throughout town.

In 2021 the town of Radium opened up a round about with an iconic piece of artwork paying tribute to the history as well to the future of the bighorn sheep. The roundabout will give you the opportunity to head further North to Golden, East to Banff or decide to stay and play in Kootenay National Park.

There are many unique hotels located in Radium to stay at that will showcase the stunning views of the valley.
