



Junior Team Evaluation Camp Host Policy

SECTION 1 – BC HOCKEY MEMBER TEAMS JURISDICTION

- 1.1 All BC Hockey Member Junior teams have the effective “draw zone” of the BC Hockey geographic region as defined by Hockey Canada (British Columbia and the Yukon Territory).
- 1.2 All BC Hockey Junior teams are permitted to hold evaluation camps within the geographic region BC Hockey, under certain conditions.
- 1.3 BC Hockey member Junior teams are not permitted to hold camps outside of the BC Hockey geographic region without the consent of the Hockey Canada / International Ice Hockey Federation (IIHF) member that has jurisdiction over the geographic region in which the camp is to be operated.
- 1.4 BC Hockey member Junior teams wanting to host or co-host camps outside of the BC Hockey geographic region must first obtain the permission of any Hockey Canada / IIHF member Association/team operating in that respective city/town.

SECTION 2 – EVALUATION CAMPS WITHIN BC

- 2.1 BC Hockey member Junior teams are not permitted to host an evaluation camp in the city or town where another BC Hockey member Junior team (of the same category) operates. Should a team wish to host a camp within BC Hockey but in market that is home to another team of the same category, a request must be filed with the BC Hockey office prior to any promotional information being produced or shared with players, coaches, parents and prior to any notice of the camp being circulated.
- 2.2 Such request will be reviewed with all teams and leagues affected.
- 2.3 Where the geographic market boundaries are in dispute, the BC Hockey Chief Executive Officer along with the BC Hockey Junior Coordinator would render a decision based on investigation from both parties.
- 2.4 The decision on such requests by BC Hockey shall be final and binding.
- 2.5 Any team operating an evaluation camp without meeting the requirements of this policy shall be subject to discipline by BC Hockey.
