## Amend 11.01 H 1

**11.01 H 1** The College shall allow each teacher at least ten working days of professional development in each academic year <u>to engage in approved academic,</u> <u>technical, industrial or other pursuits which will enhance the ability of the teacher to perform their responsibilities.</u>

### Amend 11.01 H 2

**11.01 H 2** Unless otherwise agreed between the <u>A</u> teacher and the supervisor <u>may agree</u>, <u>that</u> the allowance of ten days shall include one <u>a</u> period of <del>at least five</del> consecutive working days for professional development. <u>The teacher shall</u> <u>make any such request for consecutive professional development days</u> with a minimum of 30 days' notice.

## Amend 11.01 H 3

**11.01 H 3** The <u>nature, type and</u> arrangements for such professional development shall be made following discussion between the supervisor and the teacher <u>and is</u> subject to agreement between the supervisor and the teacher, <del>and such agreement</del> <u>which</u> shall not be unreasonably withheld.

## The balance of Article 11.01 H remains unchanged

#### Amend Article 11.03

**11.03** The academic year shall be ten months in duration and shall, to the extent it be feasible in the several Colleges to do so, be from **commence** September 1 to the

following June 30 <u>August 31</u>. The academic year shall in any event permit yearround operation and where a College determines the needs of any program otherwise, then the scheduling of a teacher in one or both of the months of July and August shall be on a consent or rotational basis.

#### Amend 11.04 B 1

**11.04 B 1** The College shall allow each Counsellor and Librarian at least ten working days of professional development in each academic year <u>to engage in approved</u> <u>academic, technical, industrial or other pursuits which will enhance the</u> <u>ability of the Counsellor or Librarian to perform their responsibilities</u>.

#### Amend 11.04 B 2

**11.04 B 2** Unless otherwise agreed between the <u>A</u> Counsellor<u>/</u> or Librarian and the supervisor <u>may agree</u>, <u>that</u> the allowance of ten days shall include one <u>a</u> period of at least five consecutive working days for professional development. <u>The</u> <u>Counsellor/Librarian shall make any such request for consecutive</u> <u>professional development days with a minimum of 30 days' notice.</u>

#### Amend 11.04 B 3

**11.04 B 3** The <u>nature, type and</u> arrangements for such professional development shall be made following discussion between the supervisor and the Counsellor or Librarian <u>and is</u> subject to agreement between the supervisor and the Counsellor or Librarian, and such agreement <u>which</u> shall not be unreasonably withheld.

#### The balance of Article 11.04 remains unchanged
